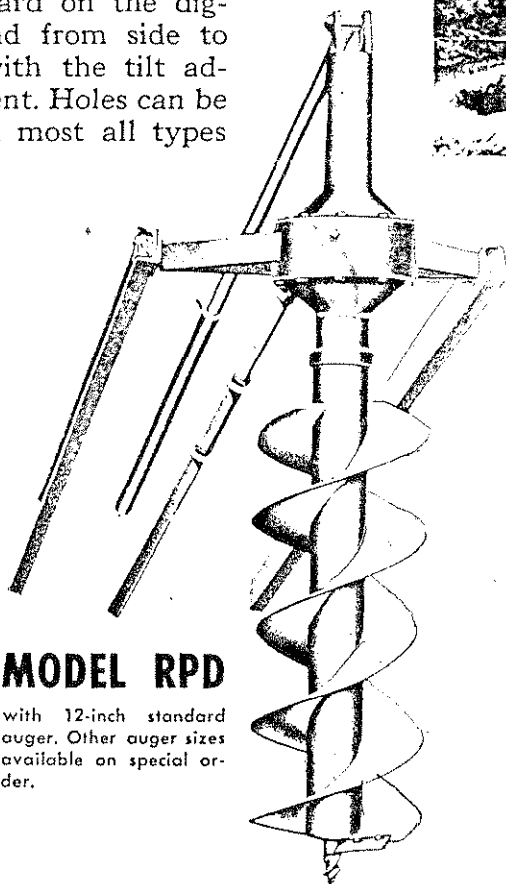
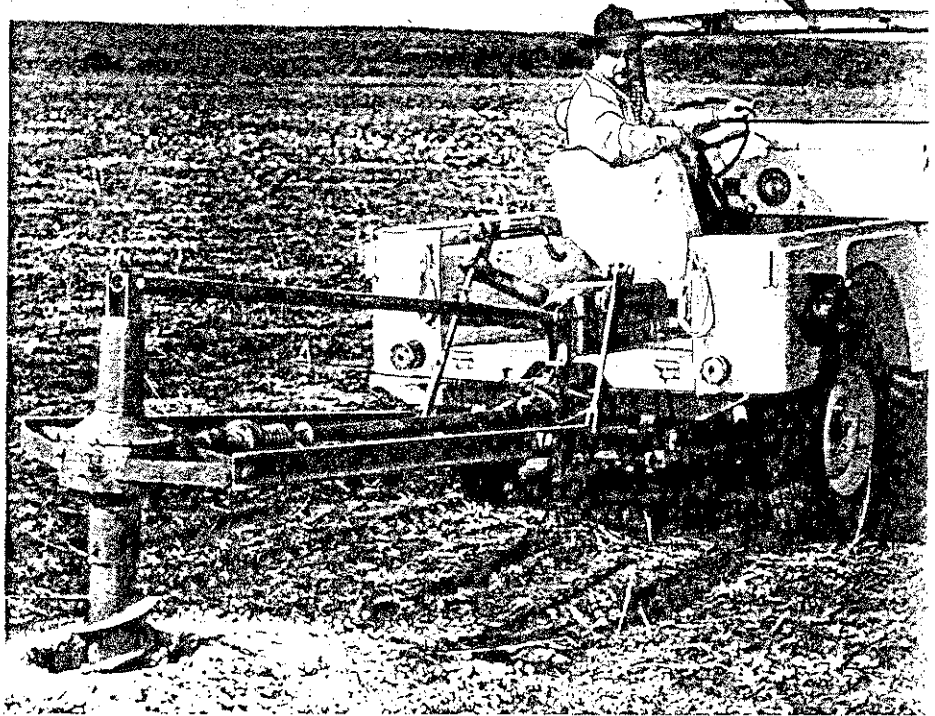

A Post Hole a Minute

The Universal 'Jeep' with post hole digger attachment makes an extremely mobile unit that gets to the job fast and digs post holes quickly—one a minute. Post hole digger attaches to the 'Jeep's' power take-off and to the Monroe Hydraulic Lift. Down pressure of the lift, adjustable up to 500 lbs., aids in digging. The auger may be reversed when the hole is dug—there is no clogging or sticking in the ground. Angle digging may be made through adjustments forward and backward on the digger, and from side to side with the tilt adjustment. Holes can be dug in most all types of soil.
