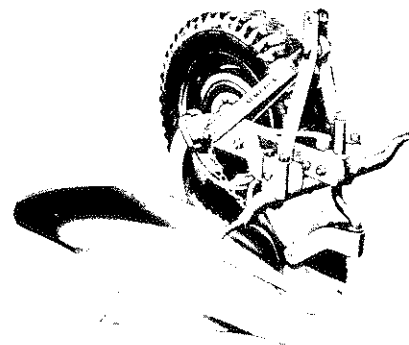

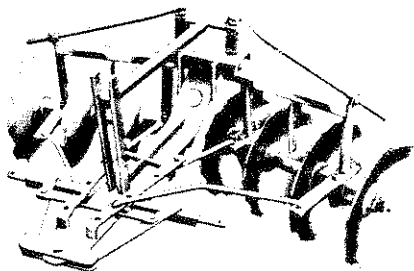
2-BOTTOM 12" GENERAL PURPOSE
MOULDBOARD PLOW



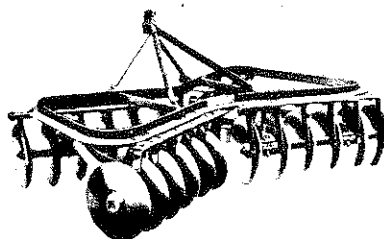
2-26" DISC PLOW



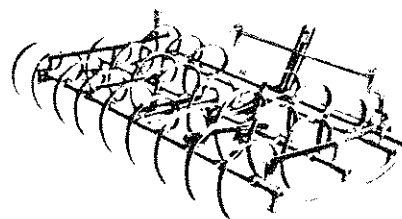
SINGLE BOTTOM 16"
MOULDBOARD PLOW



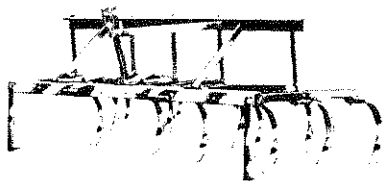

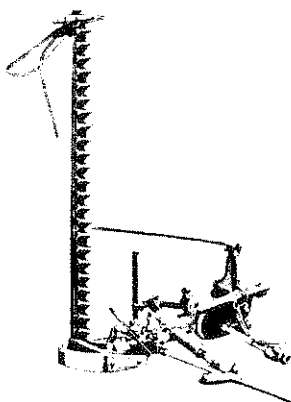
TANDEM DISC HARROW



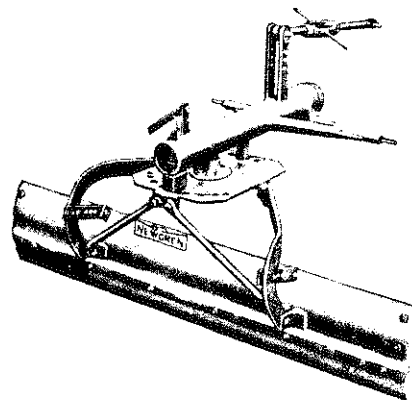

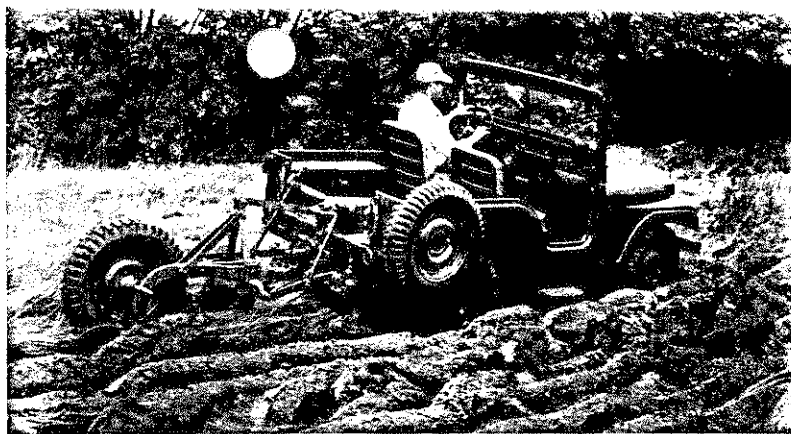

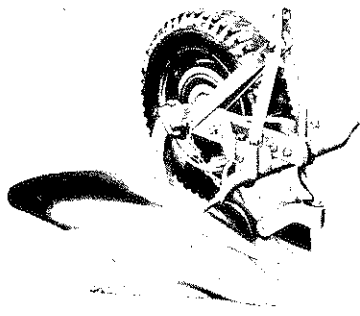

PLOWS

SINGLE BOTTOM 16-IN. MOLDBOARD PLOW

This plow is a general purpose base plow capable of operating under practically all conditions. The single bottom plow is ideal for deep plowing and covering heavy cover crops. One single adjustment is all that is needed, enabling the plow to cut a clean and even furrow.



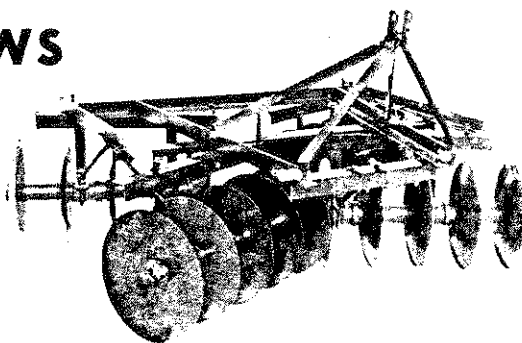
DOUBLE BOTTOM 12-IN. MOLDBOARD PLOW

This plow has the same general purpose base as the 16" single bottom plow. It is used where shallower plowing is required and the high clearance assures clean plowing under heavy trash and tall weed conditions. Ideal plowing depth is 6".

HARROWS

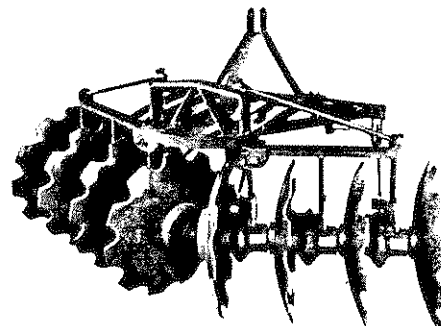
LIFT-TYPE TANDEM DISC HARROW

Heavy enough to give excellent penetration, yet this harrow is light enough for easy maneuvering with the Universal 'Jeep'. Works well in any type soil that requires discing. Sizes available: 6-ft., 18-in. blades; 6-ft., 16-in. blades; 7-ft., 18-in. blades; 7-ft., 16-in. blades.



BUSH AND BOG HARROW

Sharp, rugged, cutaway blades make this harrow an exceptional land-breaking implement, often used where terrain is too rough for plowing. The hydraulic lift provides down pressure which in turn gives extra weight to the implement itself. This means greater ability to shear off and cut through rough lands and heavy growths.
